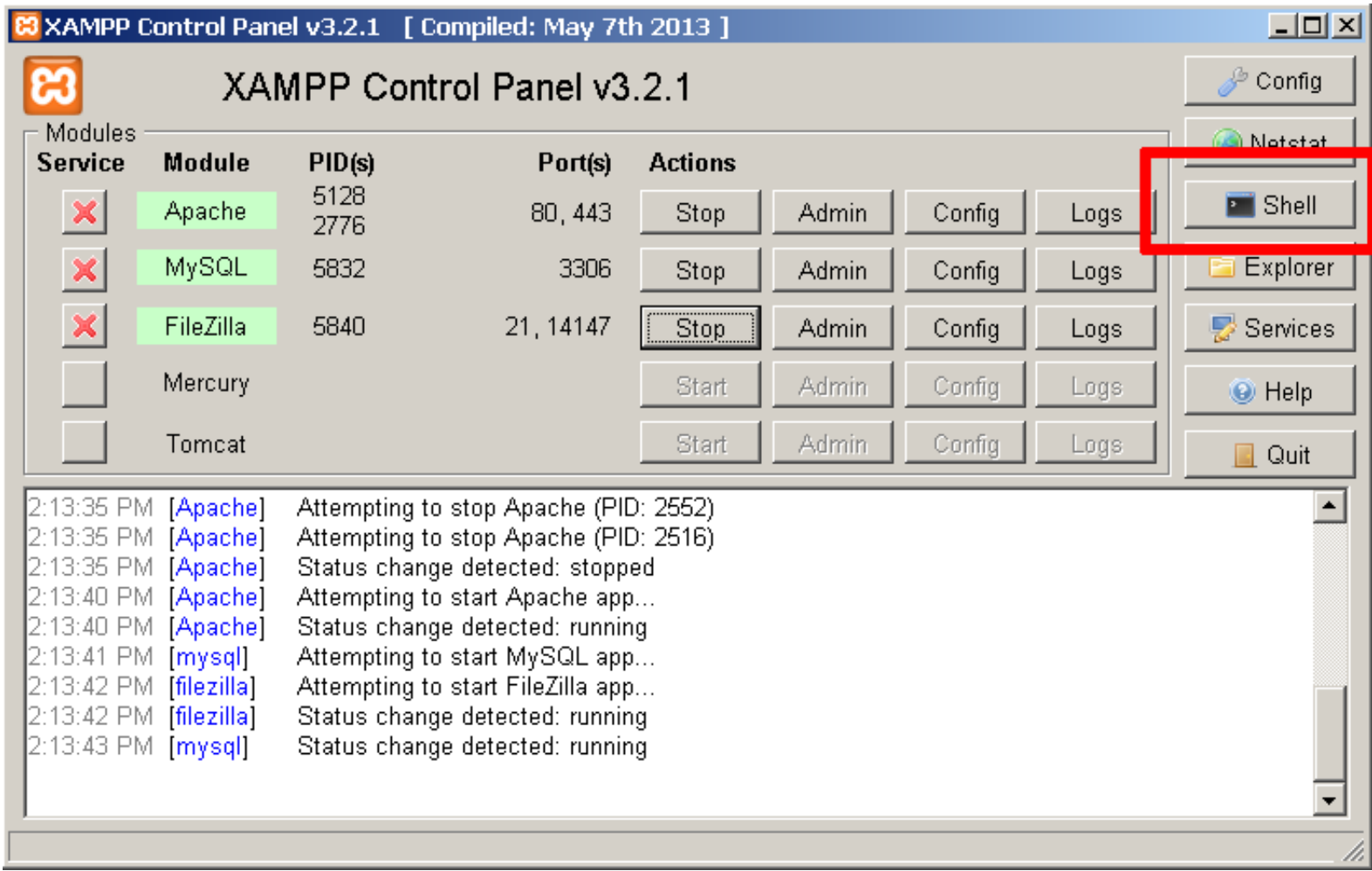

That's it, simply reboot your system and then boot the installation In case you want to reset the password of the MySQL root account, you need to force the MySQL database server to stop and restart without using grant table MySQL by default sets the username to root and there's no password. You can now run mysql -u root -p and be logged in without a password.. To do this, type the following command, replacing new-password with the new root password: UPDATE mysql.user SET Password=PASSWORD(' new-password') Set New MySQL root user password using MySQL Prompt — Set New MySQL root user password using UniController.
